“C” Classes

Lite C — (80-250 cc) “C” Riders
Open C — (251-Open cc) “C” Riders
30+ C — “C” riders age 30 or over
40+ C — “C” riders age 40 or over

Special Classes

50+ A — “A” riders age 50 or over
55+ A — “A” riders age 55 or over
40+ B — “B” riders age 40 or over
